



FIELDSTONE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION POOL RULES

1. This facility is for the exclusive use of Fieldstone residents and their guests.
2. Residents must gain admittance with their key cards and must sign in upon entry.
3. Two guests per adult resident are allowed in the pool area but must always be accompanied by the resident.
4. Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children at all times.
5. Children 12 years of age or younger must be accompanied by an adult that is 18 years of age or older at all times
6. All patrons must shower before entering the pool.
7. Babies must wear swim diapers at all times. (no disposable diapers)
8. All patrons must wear appropriate swim attire. No Athletic shorts, cut offs, or t-shirts are allowed inside the pool
9. Patrons are not allowed to bring pets inside the facility
10. No glass containers will be allowed inside the facility
11. Running or rough housing by patrons will not be tolerated. Foul language will also not be tolerated.
12. There is NO SMOKING inside the pool facility at any time.
13. There is NO Diving in the pool at any time.
14. There is NO ALCOHOL in the pool at any time.
15. Intoxicated patrons will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave the facility. All incidents will be reported to management and further actions could be taken including but not limited to revocation of pool privileges for the season.
16. A safety break will be called the last 10 minutes of every hour.
17. The pool will be closed at the first sound of thunder, or the first sighting of lightning for 30 minutes. All patrons must vacate the facility at this time. The 30 minutes limit will re-start each time thunder or lightning is observed by the lifeguards.
18. The lifeguard has the final and ultimate authority.
