## POOL RULES

1. No one will be admitted without a valid facility pass.
2. No one is allowed in the pool unless a lifeguard is on duty.
3. All children age 12 and under must be accompanied, while at the pool, by a person at least 18 years of age.
4. Pass holders, ages 13 years and older, may bring 2 guests per day ages 13 years and older. Pass holder is responsible for guest behavior. Any violation by guest or pass holder, can result in all people in violating party being suspended from the pool for one day.
5. Persons with open cuts and sores are not allowed in the pool.
6. Proper swimming attire required (i.e. no cutoffs, T-shirts, etc.).
7. No pets, except service animals, are permitted on pool premises.
8. Only small floating items, upon pool manager's discretion, will be allowed in the pool.
9. There will be a ten-minute rest period every hour. All swimmers under 18 years of age must be out of the pool.
10. The use of cocoa butter, baby oil, and other heavy suntan oils causes filter damage. It is advised that these lotions not be used at the pool.
11. No swimming after designated swim hours, unless special arrangements have been made through the board of directors.
12. Only lifeguards are allowed in the guardroom and pump room.
13. Patrons should not talk with the guard on the stand unnecessarily.
14. **No diving allowed.**
15. Glass containers are not allowed in the pool or pool area.
16. Food, drinks, and gum are not allowed in the pool.
17. Tobacco products and alcoholic beverages are not allowed in the pool or pool area.
18. No running or rough play.
19. No loud, abusive, or vulgar language.
20. No balls, frisbees, or throwing toys allowed.
21. No electrical cords allowed. Battery operated radios, bluetooth speakers, etc., allowed, only at a low volume.
22. All swimmers will be cleared from the pool at the first sound of thunder until 30 minutes after the last peal or until the storm has cleared in accordance with The National Lightning Safety Institute.
23. If fecal matter is discovered in the pool, the pool will be closed as many days as is necessary to conform to safety precautions prescribed by Montgomery County Environmental Consumer Health Services.
24. No swimmer having received three suspensions from the pool will be readmitted until the swimmer's parents/guardians or the adult swimmer has met with the Board of Directors.
25. Lifeguards are employed to insure the safety of the swimmers. They have the authority to remove from the pool area anyone disobeying the rules or endangering the safety of himself or another person. The lifeguard has the authority to suspend the offender from the pool for one or more days. Repeat violations may result in revocation of swimming privileges for the remainder of the summer as provided for in the deed restrictions.
26. Parents/Guardians are responsible for their children at all times.
